

Privacy Policy v. 1.0

IntoGolf respects and protects the privacy of online customers. IntoGolf recognizes the need to protect and properly manage the personal identifiable information ("Personal Information") that you provide to us.

IntoGolf has prepared this Online Privacy Policy so that you understand with how much care we intend to treat your personal information.

Personal information is defined as all the information with whom an individual can be identified, including, but not limited to, a first and a last name, a home address or other physical address, an email address or other contact information, as well commercial and private, gameplay and consumer behavior. Generally, you can visit IntoGolf's Web pages without telling us who you are or revealing personal information about yourself.

IntoGolf strives to comply with all laws that are worldwide addressed to protect your privacy. Although legal requirements can differ from country to country, IntoGolf seeks to adhere to the principles that are put forth in this Online Privacy Policy, in other words, our aim is to protect your personal data.

Cookies and other tracking technologies

Some web pages of IntoGolf utilize "cookies" and other tracking technologies. A "Cookie" is a small text file which can for example be used for data collection on your activity on the website. Cookies and other technologies may serve to

retrieve previously passed personal data. In most browsers, you have control over the cookies by accept or rejecting them.

In most browsers, you have the option to let a warning appear when you receive a cookie or you may choose to block cookies with your browser. Please however, note that if you choose to erase or block cookies, your original user ID and password will reset each time, and therefore you will have to enter these again to access certain parts of the website.

IntoGolf does not use tracking technology to record your Internet behavior.

IntoGolf adheres to the following principles to protect your privacy:

1. Personal Information

If IntoGolf collects personal information on the Internet, a statement will explain why this personal data is collected and indicate whether IntoGolf intends to pass this data to companies outside IntoGolf or to companies who act on behalf of IntoGolf. IntoGolf will not provide personal information to third parties that are not acting on behalf of IntoGolf without your permission except if such transfer is legally required. However, this is one exception that we must perform forced:

There are numerous golf courses and golf clubs that use the IntoGolf software. These jobs register personal information of their customers (the golfers). If your personal data is known to us due to the collaboration with your golf course or golf club, any changes in the personal data on the websites of IntoGolf will be supplied automatically to the golf course or golf club. This is because otherwise a difference in personal data may arise and possibly problems with booking tee times, lessons or enrollment in competitions may occur.

2. Your Choice

You decide whether you provide IntoGolf with your personal information. If you choose not to provide the personal information requested by IntoGolf, you can still visit most of IntoGolf's websites, but you can not access certain options, offers and services whereby interaction is needed. Again, here too the exemption shall apply that when you provide your personal information to a golf course or golf club which makes use of the IntoGolf software, this information will be automatically known by IntoGolf. This is because IntoGolf takes care of the software service and database management for these golf courses and that the golf courses offer their products to their customers through the IntoGolf websites.

If you choose to start an explicit relationship with IntoGolf by contract or via an other business relationship, we will naturally only contact you in terms of business services.

3. Security

Wherever your personal information may be held within IntoGolf, IntoGolf aims to take all reasonable and appropriate steps required to protect the personal data you have entrusted us against unauthorized access or disclosure.

4. Access and Accuracy

When you provide us with your personal information, IntoGolf wishes to ensure that they are correct.

IntoGolf will not pass on any personal data without your consent to third parties that do not act on behalf of IntoGolf, unless such transfer is legally required. It is also contrary to the policy of IntoGolf to distribute or sell your online collected personal data without your permission.
